Project 1

Audio Bibles

Over the last 30 years, the power of God's Word through the bible has been evident in the lives of Yawo people in Malawi & Mozambique

The Yawo culture is an oral one and many rely on others to read the bible to them. Teams in Malawi and Mozambique have experienced success in sharing audio bibles with communities.

Our Goal: to raise enough money for 600 Malawi Translation Audio bibles to distribute throughout communities we have contact with.

Together we can help make the bible accessible for the growing number of seekers wanting to hear the Good News of Jesus!

Project 2

Bikes & Bible College

Philippines / Vietnam / India

Each year motorbikes are purchased and provided for evangelists and pastors who visit hard to reach remote areas, nurturing and evangelising to persecuted Christians. Each Bike costs around \$2000

Mindanao, Philippines

The persecution of Christians in Mindanao is quite severe. A VOM supported college in Mindanao aims to train & equip men and women for ministry. Funds are supplied to sponsor students for enrolment, accommodation, meals, textbooks etc. Cost for a Student/year is \$700.

Project 3

Derk has been researching organic waste digestion and biogas production at FC College, South Asia. Research has resulted in the need to upscale the plant to create a small prototype for a larger facility that the college will need to deal with regular gas shortages in the future. The prototype will need 2 large plastic tanks & 1 steel tank for gas production and storage. The money would also help contribute to building supplies such as concrete pad and roof.

Susan is busy teaching 300 students who identify as Christian, conducting bible studies and hopes to employ & train short term interns (6-12 months). She is in need of writing resources, seminar resources that she is running, furniture for the prayer/chat/reading room and desks.
